



# Health & Safety

## What to Expect

It is our pleasure to share with you the following procedures that have been developed in conjunction with local Health agencies, US Coast Guard and MLB standards to help protect our clients and crew. Our standards not only meet, but exceed all regulatory requirements to provide the greatest level of safety. Our already robust hygiene standards have been reviewed and enhanced. Please review our health and safety protocols below.



### **Pre Boarding**

An online health questionnaire must be filled out by each guest prior to arriving at Pier 40 for each charter. After completing the health questionnaire a temperature check will occur prior to boarding the vessel.



### **Face Coverings**

As part of our health safeguards, we require that you wear a mask at all times in passenger areas as well as outdoors in public areas. Children under 2 years old must not wear a face covering. Children 2 to 5 years old should try to wear a face covering. Children over 6 years old must wear a face covering.



**Social Distancing:** Announcements, signage and crew members will provide guidance on maintaining safe distances from other guests. Seating will allow and encourage at least 6 ft between passengers. Passengers that are together as couples or families will be allowed to be together and share food and beverages without face coverings.



**Vessel Dining:** All charters will feature unique seasonal menu items, freshly prepared in compliance with all state and local CDC Food Safety Standards. In accordance with enhanced PPE safety protocols, our chef prepares all food items wearing gloves and a face mask which are changed frequently. All galley equipment and work stations are sanitized after each use. Each meal is individually sealed in packaging with minimal handling. Our food is served with utensils that have been sanitized, wrapped and sealed for your protection. An assortment of individually sealed condiments will also be provided during service.



**Shared spaces:** Passengers are required to stay in the open air portions of the yacht except for brief periods, such as to use the restroom. We encourage guests to plan accordingly for all weather elements. All four of our restrooms will be sanitized and restocked throughout each event as part of our elevated cleanliness protocols and standards. We are pleased to provide hot running water, antibacterial hand washing soap, disposable towels and hand sanitizer in all restrooms, with placards displaying proper use and frequency of proper handwashing as part of our heightened standards for hygiene and cleanliness.



**Personal Protection Equipment:** It is our pleasure to also provide PPE for guests prior to boarding. You will notice our Captain, crew and staff wearing personal equipment such as gloves and masks at all times.
